

### **Dr. David Flanigan**

Ohio State University Medical Center - Ohio

Dr. Flanigan is a Professor of Orthopedics at OSU where he serves as Director of the Cartilage Restoration Program, Fellowship Director of Orthopedic Sports Medicine, and Team Physician for the OSU Athletic Department. He obtained his medical degree from the University of Iowa School of Medicine, completed his residency at Northwestern University Medical School, and completed his fellowship at the University of Wisconsin Hospitals and Clinics. His specialty lies in knee-related injuries with emphasis on acute and complex knee injuries, knee ligament reconstruction, meniscus repair and transplantation, and cartilage restoration. Dr. Flanigan is regarded as an esteemed leader in ACL Reconstruction and Revision and a thought leader in meniscus repair. He co-founded the first Cartilage Restoration Program in Ohio. He has over 200 publications and has made over 80 research presentations at numerous national and international societies.



### **Dr. Paul Favorito**

The Christ Hospital - Ohio

Dr. Favorito is an orthopaedic surgeon and the Division Chief of the Shoulder and Upper Extremity Service at The Christ Hospital. He earned his medical degree from the State University of New York at the Buffalo School of Medicine and completed his residency there as well with the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery. He then completed a Sports Medicine fellowship at The Christ Hospital Bone and Joint Institute and University of Cincinnati College of Medicine. Dr. Favorito has worked as team physician for the Cincinnati Bengals, Cincinnati Cyclones, and Cincinnati Swarm. He served as the co-medical director for the ATP and WTA tennis tournaments in Mason, Ohio for 10 years, medical director for the Cincinnati Ballet, and team physician for Anderson High School. Dr. Favorito's research focuses on the shoulder, with multiple peer-reviewed publications. He has spoken around the world to share his research and has served as international faculty in 6 continents.
